## FAB-Racing CORONAVIRUS UPDATE – 2nd July 2020

Much is happening in quick succession and it is hard to keep up with all the changes.

Things to take note, much of which has been covered before still better repeated than missed.

- 1) We can now get back to competition events subject to maintaining awareness that the virus has not gone away and managing the spread of the disease is a major priority.
- 2) We must remember that Government guidance can be viewed in different ways by varying local authorities. We are also reliant upon circuit owners allowing us to use their land and must abide by any rules that they may impose.
- 3) You need to be very aware of the amount of space that is available in the paddock and any viewing areas around the track, making sure social distancing can be maintained. The government have stated that the 2m rule can be relaxed and are now calling it 1m +, the plus in this statement refers to the wearing of masks!
- 4) Face masks must be worn at all times walking around in the paddock, in the holding area, and if helping riders on the grid. All Senior classes must NOT have grid assistance, and after Race 1 both of the Metrakit classes can no longer have grid assistance. Riders do not need face masks when wearing full face helmets.
- 5) You need to be VERY SENSIBLE (please) in the parking of vehicles, that means as far as is possible, parking in neat lines. It also means no social areas / 'corrals', are to be created. No parking spaces to be reserved by taping off etc.
- 6) Events are currently NO SPECTATOR events, this means people turning up solely to watch the event. Any non riders attending the event MUST arrive along with competitors. That is also restricted, unless there is a legitimate reason otherwise, to one other person with an adult rider, or two with an under 18 year old rider, one of those two to be a parent or guardian. We strongly recommend that the additional person with an adult rider should be able to drive the vehicle being used to arrive at the meeting.
- 7) Competitors must be pre-booked into the event in advance, no entries on the day of the event, this will allow us to create a checking in list of competitors.
- 8) Any person showing symptoms before the event MUST not attend, and if showing symptoms at the circuit should immediately pack up and leave, informing the organiser by phone.
- 9) Those considered to be high risk due to age or health should not attend the event.
- 10) No trading permitted at events other than the 2 approved spares suppliers.
- 11) Please ensure you have face masks, gloves, and hand sanitiser available for your personal use at the events. We will have SOME available at the event.

Now we are back to running events, we MUST accept that things are not yet back to normal and all work together to act responsibly to minimise the risk of a second spike in the spread of COVID19 and a further lockdown.

Everybody must stay alert and play their part in continuing to be able to run events. We must take a zero-tolerance stance on those that ignore the threat and make sure that they are aware of the need to follow guidance.
